Board Eligibility

A candidate for the Board must be:

- -A USBC member in good standing of the association at the time of election and throughout their term.
- -Within 45 days of the start of their term, have completed the SafeSport training and enrolled in the Registered Volunteer Program.
- -Elected or appointed without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin, or age, other than the minimum age of 14, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership.

Note: A bowling center proprietor is an individual who is the owner, partner, or corporate officer of a bowling center or group of bowling centers. Excluded from the definition of proprietor is an individual who owns 25% or less of the equity shares, or who is inactive in the management of the bowling center and remains so during a term as an officer or director.
