#### Requirements

- ❖ Must be a graduating senior in high school and a current Non-Professional USBC member in good standing who has not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to Aug 1<sup>st</sup> of the current bowling season.
- ❖ Must have been competing in the sport of bowling for the past three years (current year counts as one of the three) and have a LIUSBC book average for the previous two years and must be a current season member of a LIUSBC certified league.
- Must have displayed qualities of good sportsmanship, integrity, compassion and a love for the sport of bowling.
- ❖ SERVICE and Skills will be considered.
- High School transcript/Report Card and two Letters of Recommendation required (Coach, Teacher, Guidance Counselor, etc.)
- \* Recipient will be recognized at the Long Island USBC Annual Dinner, Tuesday, August 6th, 2024.
